## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The class rules of the J80 will apply. The weight limit will not apply. This series is designated as an "open regatta" for the J80 class, as per J80 class rule C.2.2.
- 1.4 Racing rule 44 will be changed as follows: only one turn shall be required of a boat that breaks a rule of Part 2 while racing. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The skipper of each boat must be employed by a company that is a current member of Sail America.
- 3.2 All members of the crew shall be employees or representatives of their team's sponsor. Additional crew members may be added with the permission of the Organizing Committee. The Organizing Committee may also assign crew members with fewer than four people.
- 3.3 Entries are limited to 6 teams.
- 3.4 The entry fee is \$500 per boat. The entry fee includes an official regatta T-shirt, post-race BBQ, awards, and great racing! Entrants will also receive a goodie bag filled with lots of great stuff.

### **5 SCHEDULE**

#### **5.1 Dates of racing:**

No warning signal will be made after 1900

- 5.2 Number of races: The race committee will run up to 5 races for the event, conditions permitting; no warning signal will be made after 1900.

## **6 REGISTRATION**

## **7 THE COURSES**

The diagrams in Attachment A show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

## **8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**8.1** For all classes, rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

## **9 SCORING**

**9.1** A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If six races are completed, each boat shall exclude her worst score.

## **10 PRIZES**

The winning team will receive the Sailing Industry Regatta trophy. Team awards will be presented to the top three finishing teams. Medals will be awarded to each crew member of the top three finishing teams.

## **11 BOATS & EQUIPMENT**

**11.1** The regatta will be raced using J80s provided by J World Annapolis

**11.2** Each boat must be sailed with a crew of four.

**11.3** A J World sailing instructor will be on board for the duration of the Regatta.

**11.4** Boats and sails will be provided by J World Annapolis. Spinnakers will be used. No Adjustments to the standing rigging will be allowed

**11.5** Boats will be drawn randomly by the Organizing Committee.

**11.6** A Coast Guard-approved PFD must be worn at all times while afloat, except for brief Periods while adding or removing clothing. PFDs will be available at J World.

## **11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

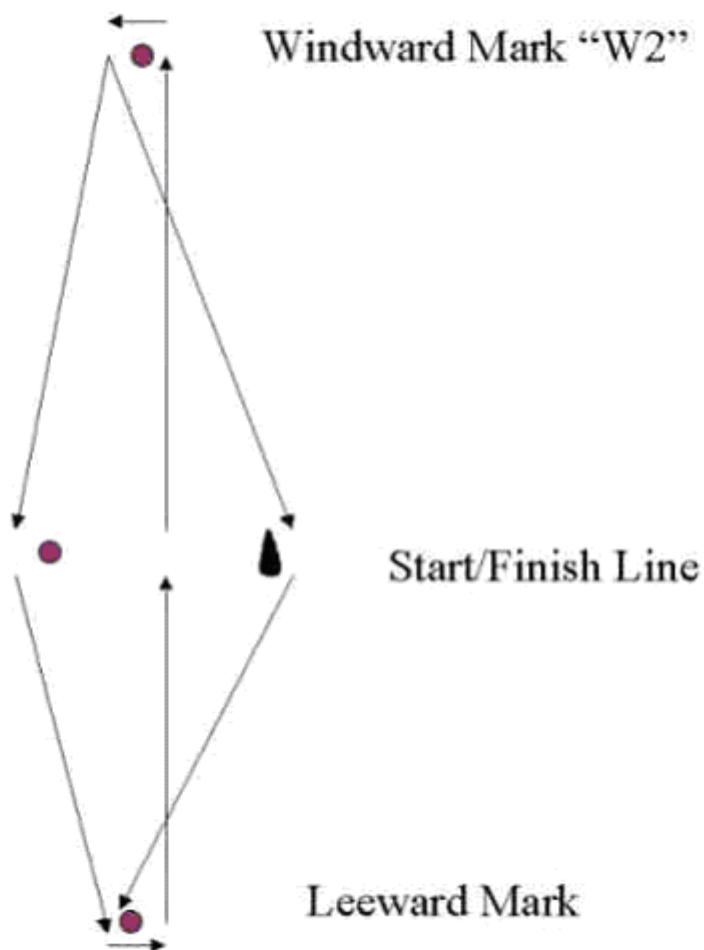
